Many public buildings, including schools and hospitals, built between the 1940s and 1980s have been built using products containing asbestos.

Intact and undisturbed asbestos material generally does not pose a health risk.

Asbestos - containing materials have been identified within the Galbraith building.

There is no need for alarm, a program of asbestos remediation is underway including asbestos removal and repair work, air monitoring and control.

Asbestos removal work is carried out by specialist contractors using strict safety procedures and specialist equipment.
