Official Information Act (1982) Request

I write in response to your Official Information Act request, which we received on 15 August 2018, via transfer from the Department of Internal Affairs, under section 14 of the Act. You requested the following information:

- **Please supply information on car parking income received from all District Health Boards, from January 2018 to date.**

At Counties Manukau District Health Board, our car-parking arrangements vary on each of our sites.

At Middlemore Hospital, we have a Grant of Concession arrangement, which grants the holder (currently the Accident Compensation Corporation), the right to operate the car-park and collect fees from users, and requires them to maintain and repair the parking facilities. Counties Manukau Health does not receive any revenue (and never has) from this parking. Any revenue is retained by ACC. While Counties Manukau Health owns the buildings and the land, this concession arrangement enabled development of the additional carpark capacity at the site several years ago.

Parking is free at the Manukau Super Clinic / Surgery Centre, as well as at all our community services sites.

I trust this information satisfactorily answers your query. If you are not satisfied with this response you are entitled to seek a review of the response by the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act.
