Official Information Act (1982) Request

I write in response to your Official Information Act request, dated 28 November 2018. You requested the following information related to DHB energy supplies:

- **For the last financial year, the annual billed cost (including lines and/or delivery charges) for commercially supplied energy for each fuel type (electricity, natural gas, coal, or other).**
- **The number of boilers or furnaces in operation, separated by type (gas, coal, bio-mass, or other).**

For Counties Manukau Health, the following details (**table 1**) address your request for fuel types used and spending by CM Health. This includes costs at all DHB-owned sites, and at community-based lease/rental property (10) used by CM Health to deliver services. Please note, this doesn't include vehicle fuel costs.

We have nineteen (19) boilers which are all gas-fired; of these thirteen (13) also have back-up diesel burner supply.
