Official Information Act (1982) Request

I write in response to your Official Information Act request dated 05 June 2018. You requested the following information:

A break down on how much money each DHB spent on rolling out the consultation period with the pharmacy sector for the *Integrated Pharmacist Services in the Community Agreement* this year.

• I am requesting the dollar figure spent within each DHB on staff flights, accommodation, staff travel allowance, venue hire, catering, marketing, PR strategy, video etc - basically all the costs involved in rolling out the new contract and the consultation period.

During the consultation process, Counties Manukau District Health Board (CMDHB) shared the costs of a Regional Meeting to present the *Integrated Pharmacist Services in the Community* Agreement to our community pharmacists and other stakeholders.

The final amount that CMDHB paid for venue hire and catering was \$1,479.00 (incl GST)

I trust this information satisfactorily answers your query. If you are not satisfied with this response you are entitled to seek a review of the response by the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act.
