Official Information Act (1982) Request

I write in response to your Official Information Act request received by us on 22nd November 2019. You requested the following information:

 All presentations to DHB EDs on Christmas Day, between 0001 and 2359, on December 25, in 2018, 2017 and 2016, broken down by emergency department/ hospital (if there is more than one) and the ICD code/ presenting complaint.

As context for this response, Counties Manukau Health (CM Health) provides health and support services to people living in the Counties Manukau region (approx. 569,400 people), as well as regional and supra regional specialist services (Burns, Plastics and Orthopaedics). Our services are delivered via hospital, outpatient/ ambulatory and community-based models of care. We see more than 118,000 presentations at the Middlemore Hospital Emergency Department each year.

Response:

The Middlemore Hospital Emergency Department presentations on Christmas day for 2016, 2017 and 2018 were (Table 1):

The range of presenting symptoms is wide. We have listed total presentation broken down to ICD Diagnostic Related Group (DRG) codes (where coding occurred for patients subsequently admitted to hospital), for those with more than 3 or more cases occurring on a Christmas day (Table 2). These signal both the type and severity of conditions within a code.

We are also providing the same data, but listed by principal diagnosis, assigned by the clinical coding process (Table 3).

Because not all Emergency Department cases will require hospitalisation, about half the presentations in the data are not 'coded', and will only have free-text on presenting symptoms relevant to each individual seen, are noted in the ED documentation system. These free-text entries (for more than 900 presentations) are not able to be collated without significant manual review and checking in a manner that will provide information for your request, without detailing personal health information.

In addition, due to the identifiable nature of the information, the extended data tables provided here have also had any instances on a single presentation for a condition/ code in a year manually removed, and therefore do not equal the total presentations occurring for the day (which is noted at the in the table), but do give an indication on the range of presentations types.

I trust this information satisfactorily answers your query. If you are not satisfied with this response you are entitled to seek a review of the response by the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act.
