## Official Information Act Request for – Australian Citizen or Graduate RMOs

I write in response to your request under the Official Information Act received on 24 September 2020, requesting the following information:

 How many RMOs employed by the DHB are Australian citizens or graduates of an Australian Medical School and a breakdown of these employees stating whether each one is a house officer or registrar, and their specialty.

## Counties Manukau Health Response:

Counties Manukau Health (CM Health) has a total of 29 RMOs employed at the DHB as of 22 September 2020 that are Australian citizens or graduates of an Australian Medical School. The breakdown of these employees by RMO Type and their specialty is detailed in table 1 below.

For context CM Health employs over 7,500 staff and provides health and support services to people living in the Counties Manukau region (approx. 569,400 people). We see over 118,000 people in our Emergency Department each year, and over 2,000 visitors come through Middlemore Hospital daily.

Our services are delivered via hospital, outpatient, ambulatory and community-based models of care. We provide regional and supra-regional specialist services i.e. for orthopaedics, plastics, burns and spinal services. There are also several specialist services provided including tertiary surgical services, medical services, mental health and addiction services.
